Manufactured under the watchful eye of the Raciaes Cubanas Factory in Danli, Honduras. The filler is bale aged from 2 to 3 years and comes from the fertile valleys of Jalapa, Nicaragua. The binder and wrapper are aged a minimum of 2 years and come from the prized farms of Trojes, Honduras.

I named the cigar in honor of my Dad; Carmine Pietro. My Dad was a man of honor, who instilled in me strong values that I am able to pass on to my own family today. He taught me great life lessons about family, honor and loyalty that have become the foundation for my success in both my personal and business life.
